The CLC working group at the United Nations in New York invites you and all our world CLC community to join in a United Nations “Call to Action” to support the fourteenth Sustainable Development Goal (SDG 14) which reads: *To conserve and sustainably use the oceans, seas, and marine resources for sustainable development.*

Last June, our CLC representatives attended the Ocean Conference held at the UN in New York. One aim of the Conference was: *“Be the inspiration that will reverse the decline in the health of our oceans for people, planet and prosperity.”* To address this aim, every organization present was asked to accept a “Call to Action.” Since this action resonates with our CLC priority areas of Ecology and Water, we accepted this call to unite with so many others of good will. We submitted a two-year voluntary “commitment” which we are calling a **CLC Ocean Care Plastics Project**. At the UN, our project is registered as: **#OceanAction21726**. So, whenever you make a related post online or via social media, be sure to include this hashtag so that it registers on our account!

To participate in this project, you can:

- **Raise Awareness!** We can educate one another about caring for our common home, protecting our oceans, and reducing plastic usage. We will be promoting our CLC Ecology materials, the Pope’s Encyclical Laudato Si, other relevant documents.
